



The 31st Annual Great Lakes Special Stockdog Trials Memorial Weekend, May 23rd, 24th, and 25th, 2009 6 Trials over 3 Days

Entries: Limited to 40 runs cattle, sheep and ducks combined per trial. ENTRIES FOR AUSTRALIAN SHEPHERDS OPEN APRIL 17, 2009, ALL OTHER BREEDS OPEN APRIL 21, 2009. (**Postmark**)

Pre-entries must be made on an official ASCA entry form and postmarked by May 8th, 2009. A waiting list in order of receipt will be maintained. You will be notified if you do NOT get your requested entry. Fill-in form available at <http://www.asca.org/Forms/StockEntry.pdf> Substitutions will be allowed only with a dog owned by the same person making the original entry. Bitches in season will run in order.

OVERNIGHT ENTRIES ARE NOT NECESSARY. ASCA RULES STATE ENTRIES WILL BE FILLED BY 'POSTMARK DATE ORDER'. DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES REQUIRING A SIGNATURE FOR RECEIPT.

Please include your e-mail for confirmation of entries. Post-dated checks will not qualify as a valid pre-entry. Cancellation of pre-entries will not be refunded unless the trial is filled. Cancellations after the Pre-Entry deadline of May 8, 2009, will not be refunded.

Classes/Divisions: Cattle (3-5 head beef type), Sheep (3-5 head dorper crosses), Ducks (5 head) Advanced, Open, Started, Novice, Junior Handler

Weekend Awards: High Combined WTCh – highest combined score over all 3 days from the advanced division on all classes of stock, for dogs that begin the trial as WTCh'd.

High Combined Other Breed (sponsored by Patswork Designs)– for highest combined score over all 3 days from the Open and/or Advanced divisions on all classes of stock.

High Combined Non-WTCh Aussie (sponsored by Karen Dearden)– highest combined scores over all 3 days from the Open & Advanced divisions on all classes of stock for a dog that begins the trials not being a WTCh.

Most Promising Aussie – highest combined score over all 3 days from the Started division on all classes of stock.

Class High Combined Score – for highest total score on each class of stock over all three days, any division.

Daily Awards: Placement ribbons for each division and class, qualifying ribbons if appropriate: High Score Started, Open, and Advanced; High Score Junior Handler, High Score Open Junior; High in Trial Aussie

General Rules: ASCA Sanctioned. All current ASCA rules apply. Individuals will be responsible for any damage done to stock and/or equipment. Dogs that attack or maul any person, dog or livestock will be disqualified. Stock replacement fee (injury is vet on-call fee) \$25 ducks, \$200 sheep, \$ market value cattle.

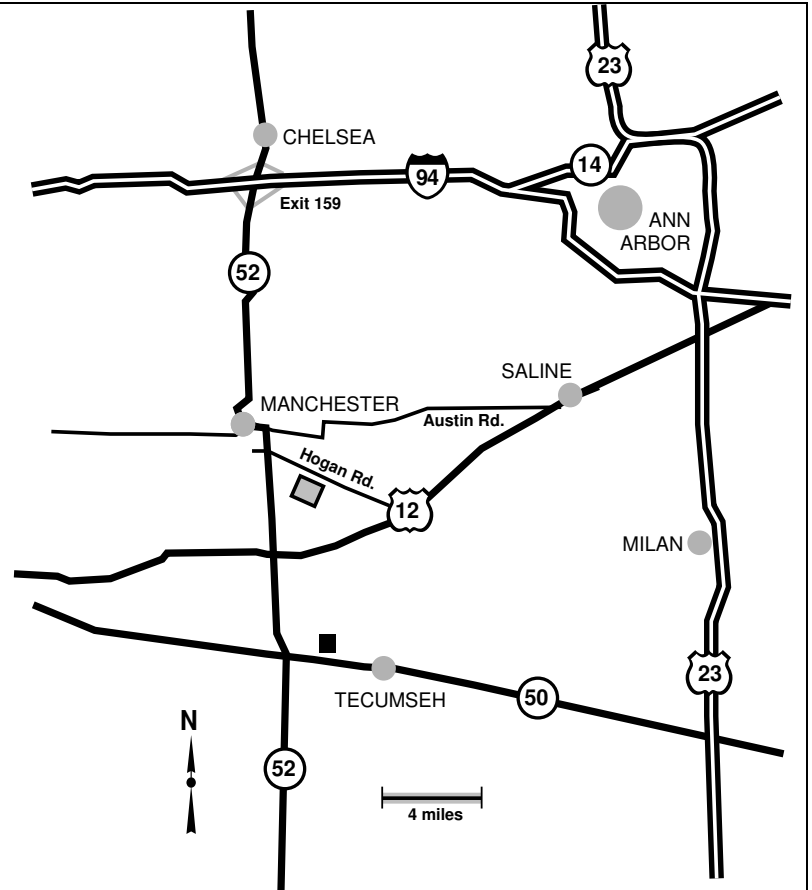
